- MITTENS, windproof, insulated, and waterproof (gloves are not accepted)
- 2 PAIRS OF RUNNING SOCKS, wool
- TRAIL RUNNING SHOES, snow-compatible, recommended with spikes
- RACING SNOWSHOES, lightweight and running-suitable
- INSULATED WATER BOTTLES, min. 3L capacity in total
- RUNNING POLES, foldable, with a wide base for snow
- THERMAL SURVIVAL BAG, Blizzard bag or survival bag (aluminum blankets not accepted)
- HIGH-ENERGY SNACKS
- HEADLAMP
- COMPASS (analog, mobile phones not accepted)
- REHYDRATION SALTS
- GPS WATCH, must be able to read and follow GPX files
- PROOF OF TRAVEL INSURANCE, must cover search and rescue, as well as evacuations

MANDATORY EQUIPMENT - TO BE TRANSPORTED BETWEEN CAMPS.

- SLEEPING BAG, comfort rating of -20°C minimum
- SLEEPING BAG LINER, insulating
- SLEEPING MAT, insulating and made for winter conditions

- BREAKFAST AND DINNER, must be prepared with boiling water. Min. 2000 kcal per day

- SUNSCREEN
- POWER BANK, for charging GPS watch
- CHARGER FOR GPS WATCH
